REMARKS: Membership shall be formed in accordance with the requirements of the “federal enabling legislation and regulations”

No fewer than 17 voting members, of these not less than 60% of this number shall consist of persons who are:

- 1} persons with DD
- 2} parents or guardians of children with DD
- 3} immediate relatives or guardians of adults with mentally impairing DD who cannot advocate for themselves

- ...of the 60%
- 1) at least, but not more than, one-third shall be persons with developmental disabilities
 - 2) at least, but not more than one-third shall be the parents / guardians of children with DD and at least one immediate relative or guardian of an institutionalized or previously institutionalized individual with a DD
 - 3) or at least one-third shall be an immediate relative / guardian of an adult w/DD
 - 4) not any employees of a state agency which receives funds or provides services under this part, or who manage employees of any other entity which receives funds or provides services for the Council, or are persons with ownership or controlling interest with respect to such an entity.

Shall at all times include a representative of:

- 1) Commonwealth agencies that administer funds provided under the Rehab. Act of 1973; Individuals with Disabilities Ed. Act.; Individuals with Disabilities Act of 1990; Older Americans Act of 1965; Titles V and XIX of the Social Security Act
- 2) University Center of Excellence programs or satellite centers on abilities studies
- 3) Commonwealth Protection and Advocacy Agency; and
- 4) Any other local agencies or non-governmental agencies and private non-profit groups in the Commonwealth concerned with services for individuals and their families w/DD

*Members shall serve no more than 2 consecutive terms, unless continued re-appointments are made by the Governor.
